Graduation Requirements

- Foundation with Endorsement and Distinguished Level of Achievement
- 4 Credits of English
- 4 Credits of Math (Must include Algebra II)
- 4 Credits of Science
- 3 Credits of Social Studies (SHS students take 4)
- 2 Credits of the Same Foreign Language
- 1 Credit of P.E.
- 1 Credit of Fine Arts
- 6 State Elective Credits
- Total 26 Credits

Graduation....

- Pass all required courses to meet your graduation requirements
- Pass all 5 STAAR E.O.C. Exams (English I & II, Algebra I, Biology, and U.S. History)
- Must meet all State of Texas attendance requirements
- Must close out all accounts and fines



Pass ALL E.O.C. Exams

- What if I have not yet passed all my E.O.C. exams?
 - Retest Opportunities
 - English I (December 10th)
 - English II (December 12th)
 - Algebra I (December 13th)
 - U.S. History (December 11th)
 - Biology (December 11th)



Attendance and Graduation


Attendance Impacts Graduation

- Unexcused absences may lead to filing in truancy court.
- Excessive absences can lead to make-up hours and credit denial.
- Students must be present in each class at least 90% in order to be eligible to receive credit. All absences, whether excused or unexcused are subject to this 90% rule.

Meet All Attendance Requirements

- Courses that require make-up hours are indicated on transcripts with an * next to the grade being withheld. These courses compute as a 0 (zero) for GPA purposes.
- Students may restore credit by completing make-up hours through:
- Teacher tutorials: before and after school
- Saturday school is available
 - In Saturday School, students receive 5 hours for 4 hours attendance

College Visits





- Schedule a campus tour to meet with a representative from Admissions Office.
- Visit the campus Financial Aid/Scholarship Office.
- Two college visits allowed per year.
 (Request form from Attendance Office prior to visit for approval.)

Suggested Senior Timeline

- Testing: TSI, SAT/ACT (now or ASAP)
- Apply Online: Apply Texas, Common App, Coalition App or specific school apps
- Request SAT/ACT test scores, and Transcripts from SHS, St. Philips, and TLU
- Complete FAFSA (opens October 1st)
- Apply for scholarships
- 6. Schedule campus visits

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- Accurate Information
 - Determines \$\$\$ available to student and if they are eligible for grants.
- Opens October 1st
 - Use 2018 Tax Returns
 - FAFSA Wednesday Oct 9th, Nov 6th
 - 4:30 pm 6:30 pm
 - Parents are invited for FAFSA assistance-call or email to reserve a seat

Texas Success Initiative

- The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) is a state-legislated program designed to improve student success in college.
- Meeting TSI standards is a requirement for entering Texas public Colleges, Universities.
